

REFLECTIONS

From the Pastor

In 1924, Bill Havens was on of America's best hopes for a gold medal at the Olympic games in Paris. He was a rower, and most experts gave him a good chance at three gold medals. But a few months before the Games, Havens realized his wife was due to deliver their first child while was on his trip to Paris. In those days he could not just hop on a jet and return in a few hours. A trip across the Atlantic took two weeks. Added to the two weeks of competition, that meant a total of six weeks away from his wife. He resolved not to leave her, and gave his spot to another.

He felt bad about leaving his teammates, one of whom was Benjamin Spock, later known as the "Baby Doctor". He always wondered about the medals he might have won. But twenty eight years later he received a telegram which meant more than any medal. It was from his son, who had won gold in the 10,000 meter canoeing final at the 1952 Helsinki Olympics. The message read, "Dear Dad, Thanks for waiting around for me to get born. I'm coming home with the gold medal you should have won. Your loving son, Frank." If he ever had doubts about whether he had made the right choice, they were resolved in that moment.

Priorities are not necessarily the things at which we spend the most time. They are the things we do when we have a choice of what to do. Fathers have to make choices like that every day. So do moms. Preachers do. Every Christian does. The results of making right choices may take years to show up. They may or may not be as dramatic as in this case. But the right choices always payoff eventually. Have you so surrendered your life to the leadership of Christ that he can impart the wisdom necessary to make the right and best choices?
