one individual and one church. Betty Galloway was the first woman ordained as a deacon in a Tennessee Baptist Church. This year, First Baptist Church of Clinton received the award. You must be nominated for the award, and FBC was nominated by Stan Elliott. Below is a picture of the award and the letter written by Stan.



TCBF Coordination Council,

I would like to nominate the congregation of First Baptist Church of Clinton, TN, as a recipient of The Betty Galloway Advocacy for Women in Ministry Award. The following are some thoughts on why I submit this nomination:

When I began serving at FBC Clinton 13 years ago, it was important to me that support for women in ministry was evident. One of the things that drew me to this congregation was the process they went through to begin having women serve as deacons. Occurring before I came, it was shared with me that the dialogue was honest and included views from many perspectives. In the end, the church voted in favor of women deacons and the whole church embraced the decision.

One of the ways this was demonstrated was in ordination services for new deacons. Though always a highlight, when the new deacon elected was female, the church seemed to turn out in higher numbers for the ordination service.

Also, in support of women deacons, I had the pleasure to serve with two women who served as chair of deacons. What a joy that was!

The staff of FBC Clinton has always supported women in ministry roles. When I arrived, the staff consisted of three full-time males serving (pastor, min. of ed., and min. of youth), and four females, two of which were in full-time ministry positions (music and administrator). Over the years, we grew to a staff of nine which included two full-time males (pastor and youth) and seven full-time women (mission and creative ministry, music, education, children, administrator, family life center, and communications). The last two positions were developed from two of the original staff, as we saw their gifts and hearts. We just celebrated the ordination of the church's female Minister of Missions and Creative Ministries!

Over the years, the congregation welcomed and supported several guest women preachers who filled the pulpit in my absence as well as some who were invited to help us celebrate special events and studies.

I would like to recognize Pastor Emeritus Sam Dean, who served the congregation for many years, for creating an atmosphere of support for women in ministry. I was able to lead in ministry in our community with women because of his foundational work.



The vote results to call Dr. Danny Chisholm as Senior Pastor of First Baptist Church were 227 yes votes and 3 no votes.


Dear friends at FBC Clinton,
