

The Chisholm Family



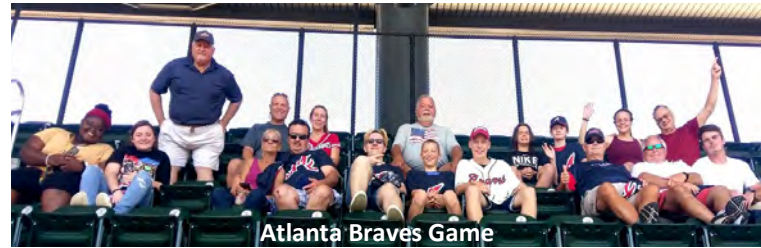

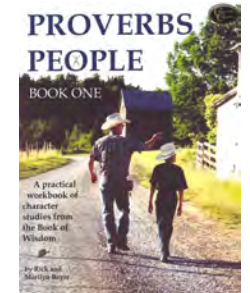
