On Monday, January 20th, I attended my first Martin Luther King, Jr. Prayer breakfast as your pastor. It was held at the Green McAdoo Cultural Center and featured Scripture, prayers, and a challenge about the life and legacy of Dr. King.

I remember a story from a previous pastorate when a little girl came forward for her profession of faith. We celebrated her baptism and rejoiced with her family. Her mom told me afterward that whenever they would drive by our building, the little girl would exclaim, "That's my church!"

I'm excited about what the Lord is doing through this church. I am so grateful for all the volunteer time and energy that is being used for the glory of God. Let's continue to be in prayer and in our place as we serve our Lord together.

Finally, I want to thank Antonio for his leadership in the contemporary worship service. He has announced his departure effective Sunday, February 23<sup>rd</sup>. We will miss him but bless him as he takes his leave of us. There will be time at the conclusion of the early service that day to express our gratitude to him.
