It's Back to School Time! Like many of you parents (and students), I'm finding it hard to believe that we're gearing up for another semester. Teachers are getting their classrooms ready, parents are getting lists for school supplies, and life will fall back into a routine once again.

The June financial report indicates that our giving year to date is approximately \$50,000 higher than it was last year. Through six months, we are running about even with giving and our expenses. This is a great accomplishment and a source of encouragement that I wanted to share with you all. Let's keep up the good work--your giving makes a difference!

There is still more yet to do this year. I am excited about the possibilities of reaching people for Christ and having them get connected with our church family. Buildings and budgets are important, but our most important resource is our people.

For years, First Baptist Church Clinton has had a Christian witness that is felt within and beyond this town. For example, our WEE Ministry and Christian Service Center remain two of our signature ministries and identifiable with this church. Countless children, individuals, and families have been impacted for Christ through these ministries.

Also, and only a few weeks ago, I spoke with a dozen African-American students who were part of a Children's Defense Fund meeting on Alex Haley Farm. They toured Green McAdoo Cultural Center and stopped by to view the Rev. Paul Turner historical marker. I gladly took photos and gave them booklets provided by the Turner Memorial Committee. These young people had never heard about the Clinton 12 or Rev. Turner's role in the desegregation of the high school.

And, our church is known for its affirmation of the biblical and theological basis for women in ministry. This month we ordain Lauren Neal and Vicki Violette to the gospel ministry. We celebrate once again the important truth that service of our Lord is based on gifts and calling rather than gender. It's a privilege to be part of this moment in their lives.

This church has had a meaningful past yet there's more Kingdom work to be done. I'm grateful we can all be part of it. Let's keep praying, giving, serving, and following Jesus and trust him with the results.
