It's also a good time to be reminded of the importance of our church family. How we treat each other is a witness to our community and world. Our treatment of each other gives witness to our fidelity to Jesus Christ and his teachings.

Jesus said, "A new command I give you: 'Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another. By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another" (John 13.34-35).

What's new about this command? It is that the criterion for our love must be that of how Christ loved us. This is a high standard, one that we must continue in our struggle to meet each and every day.


